The scholarship and financial aid options include: Scholarships and awards, State and federal grants, and Veterans Administration benefits.

STEPS FOR APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID:

1. Go to the official web address: www.fafsa.ed.gov. (Please be careful about other websites that may charge you for your information. This is the official **FREE** government website.)
2. The questions on income will be based on your 2008 income. You will need:
 - a. 2008 Federal Taxes
 - b. W-2 forms
 - c. Child support paid or received in 2008(Additional information may be requested at a later date from the financial aid office)
3. The application will ask what college you would like your information sent. **The Ogden-Weber Applied Technology College's number is: 015526.**
4. You will receive e-mail confirmation from the Dept. of Education 3-5 days after submission if you provide an e-mail address. (Please see Step #5 before you call our office!) If you do not provide an e-mail address, you will receive mailed confirmation from the Dept. of Ed at the address you provided within 15 days.
5. **Contact the OWATC Financial Aid Office no earlier than 10-14 days AFTER submission.** Call **801.627.8327** for an appointment. You may receive a recorded message. Please leave your name and phone number; we will return your call within 24-48 hours.

You MUST input our school code of 015526 in order for this college to receive your information!

Frequently Asked Questions:

***Do I need to provide my parent's information?**

If you answer "NO" to ALL the questions in Section 2, you will need your parent's information.

***Do I have to have a pin number?**

No. You may print the signature page, sign (and parent, if applicable), and mail it to the Department of Education. The address is provided on the signature page.

***What if I have forgotten my pin number?**

You may go to www.pin.ed.gov to request a duplicate pin.

Please Note: the FAFSA is not required to apply for the Ogden-Weber Applied Technology College IT Program Grant.
