Under the direction of the Marketing Student Recruitment Specialist or assigned supervisor, the Student Ambassador shall participate in the following student service areas:

Responsibilities

- Assist in the delivery of outreach programs and services targeting underrepresented populations and promote college enrollment throughout the local schools and community.
- Attend scheduled meetings and activities
- Represent the college at career fairs, school visits and other informational programs
- Lead campus tours
- Assist as needed in the planning and/or implementation of special activities such as Cinco de Mayo, Black History Month, Si Se Puede, etc.
- Submit one article each month about a student success story.
- Visit one class each week to become familiar with each program on campus and to be visible to the student population.
- Attend student orientation on a rotating schedule with other ambassadors to welcome and meet new students.
- Participate in workshops and in-service training as scheduled.
- Positively represent the OWATC student body
- Act as an ambassador from the student body to employers, alumni and prospective students at various events
- Other duties as assigned
